Yumbah Aquaculture wins gold medal

YUMBAH Aquaculture has just been named a gold medallist in the 2021 Harvey Norman Produce Awards - an annual award presented for the best produce in Australia.

Named in the "From the Sea" category was Yumbah's Greenlip Abalone Whole in Shell - produced from the company's Kangaroo Island and Port Lincoln farms.

Yumbah Aquaculture chief executive said the business was committed to sustainably growing the world's best abalone in pristine coastal environments..

"It's thanks to the hard work of all staff that Yumbah has taken out this award for a second year in a row," he

said. Fifty-nine producers were awarded a gold medal across the categories of Dairy, Earth, Paddock and Sea, with five national finalists in the Outstanding Farmers' Market category

To determine the winners, each of the products were tasted and tested by a national judging panel, which included some of the country's most renowned chefs and experts.

Yumbah will go on to compete for a produce award national trophy in August this year.
